Here, you'll find a brief Lesson Plan describing what we are learning and working on in Music Class this week, complete with the particular Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) taught or reinforced.

Here's what we're doing the week of October 10th in Music:

Kindergarten - We continue learning "I Know an Old Lady Who Swallowed a Fly," working on story sequence, singing, and instruments (TEKS: K.1a, K.1b, K.2a, K.3b, K.4a, K.4b)

1st Grade - Continuing learning about loud/soft and eurythmics with the "Grizzly Bear" song/game, "The Old Grey Cat" song/game, "All Around the Kitchen" song, and the "Radetzky March" (TEKS: 1.1a, 1.1b, 1.1c, 1.2a, 1.4a, 1.5a, 1.6a)
