

This Week In Music...

Here, you'll find a brief Lesson Plan describing what we are learning and working on in Music Class this week, complete with the particular Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) taught or reinforced.

Here's what we're doing the week of October 17th in Music:

Kindergarten - We finish our unit of "I Know an Old Lady Who Swallowed a Fly" (TEKS: K.1a, K.1b, K.2a, K.3b, K.4a, K.4b)

1st Grade - Discovering short and long sounds, using "Hunt the Cows" and the "Long and Short Dance" (TEKS: 1.1a, 1.1b, 1.1c, 1.2a, 1.3a, 1.5a, 1.5b, 1.6a)

2nd Grade - Exploring beat vs. rhythm with the song "Bate, Bate" (TEKS: 2.1b, 2.1c, 2.2a, 2.2b, 2.3a, 2.3b, 2.5a, 2.5b, 2.5c, 2.6a)

3rd Grade – Continuing to work on our BIG PTA Program!!! We'll perform it during the Annual Nebbie Night of Thanks on Thursday, November 10th!!! We'll work on several songs and even learn about special jobs! (TEKS: 3.1a, 3.1b, 3.2a, 3.2b, 3.3a, 3.5a, 3.5b)

4th Grade – We start to learn about and play RECORDERS!!! We'll even learn and play our first notes! I'll continue have them available for sale for \$4 each, as well as a class set (sanitized for each child) that can be borrowed during Music Class. If you have one at home, BRING IT!!! (TEKS: 4.1b, 4.3a)

5th Grade – We continue working on our PTA Program on Thursday, October 27th! Make sure you bring your recorders!

6th Grade Choir - Continuing working on Holiday music and musical literacy (TEKS: 6.1a, 6.1b, 6.1c, 6.2a, 6.3a, 6.3c, 6.6a)
