

This Week In Music...

Here, you'll find a brief Lesson Plan describing what we are learning and working on in Music Class this week, complete with the particular Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) taught or reinforced.

Here's what we're doing the week of April 10th (No school Monday – classes will be made up on Friday):

Kindergarten – We'll continue working on our big PTA Program! We'll continue to work on Special Jobs this week! It will be Thursday, April 20th!

1st Grade - We learn a brand-new song and game: "Who Has the Penny?" (TEKS: 1.1a, 1.1b, 1.1c, 1.2a, 1.3a, 1.5a, 1.5b, 1.6a)

2nd Grade - We'll revisit tempo with the "Kye Kye Kule (Ghana parts of body)" song/game, the "Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes" song/game, and learn a new song/game "Head and Shoulders, Baby" (TEKS: 2.1b, 2.1c, 2.2a, 2.2b, 2.3a, 2.5a, 2.5b, 2.5c, 2.6a)

3rd Grade – We continue our unit on "The Stinky Cheese Man" – adding student-selected instruments and singing (TEKS: 3.1a, 3.1b, 3.2a, 3.2b, 3.3a, 3.5a, 3.5b)

4th Grade – We continue to learn about and play RECORDERS!!! We'll learn a new song featuring a new pitch ("Old McDonald Had a Farm") and have lots of chances to earn belts!!! (TEKS: 4.1b, 4.3a)

5th Grade – BRING YOUR RECORDERS!!! We will learn "Happy Birthday to You," earn belts, and continue our contest – the "Merrily We Roll Along" Speed Challenge!!! (TEKS: 5.1b, 5.3b)

6th Grade Choir – We'll continue working on new music for a very busy second semester! (TEKS: 6.1a, 6.1b, 6.1c, 6.2a, 6.3a, 6.3c, 6.6a)
