

This Week In Music...

Here, you'll find a brief Lesson Plan describing what we are learning and working on in Music Class this week, complete with the particular Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) taught or reinforced.

Here's what we're doing the week of September 19th in Music:

Kindergarten - Finishing the "Windy Day" book/song/game – be looking for your child's "Show and Tell" page! (TEKS: K.1a, K.1b, K.2a, K.3b, K.4a, K.4b)

1st Grade - Practicing loud & soft with the "Grizzly Bear" song/game ("Remote Control" style) and the "Radetzky March" - using instruments! (TEKS: 1.1a, 1.1b, 1.1c, 1.2a, 1.4a, 1.5a, 1.6a)

2nd Grade - Continuing the "Millions of Cats" book/song/game – preparing to perform it the week of September 26th! Be on the lookout for your invitations! (TEKS: 2.1a, 2.1b, 2.2a, 2.4a, 2.5c, 2.6a)

3rd Grade – Continuing to learn about Melodic Contour and do-re-mi with the Japanese song "Kuma San" – and learning a new fishing boat song from Nigeria! We're working on a BIG surprise!!! (TEKS: 3.1a, 3.1b, 3.2a, 3.2b, 3.3a, 3.5a, 3.5b)

4th Grade – We continue working on our PTA Program!!! It will be Thursday, September 29th! We will practice and audition for instrument parts for "Oboa Asi Me Nsa," work on "Se, Se, Se," "The Punctuation Song," and "Texas, Our Texas!"

5th Grade – Finish working on composing / playing our own eight-beat rhythm patterns, working with partners and groups, using instruments that we choose to play our compositions! We'll even have a chance to play our finished projects! (5.1b, 5.3a, 5.4b, 5.6a)

6th Grade Choir - Continuing working on our first several songs, including songs for our Holiday Concert and Tour! (TEKS: 6.1a, 6.1b, 6.1c, 6.2a, 6.3a, 6.3c, 6.6a)
