

This Week In Music...

Here, you'll find a brief Lesson Plan describing what we are learning and working on in Music Class this week, complete with the particular Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) taught or reinforced.

Here's what we're doing the week of September 26th in Music:

Kindergarten - We start learning "I Know an Old Lady Who Swallowed a Fly" (TEKS: K.1a, K.1b, K.2a, K.3b, K.4a, K.4b)

1st Grade - Practicing loud & soft with the "Grizzly Bear" song/game, the "Radetzky March," and learning/playing "The Old Gray Cat" (TEKS: 1.1a, 1.1b, 1.1c, 1.2a, 1.4a, 1.5a, 1.6a)

2nd Grade - Finishing the "Millions of Cats" book/song/game – preparing to perform for our invited guests this week! (TEKS: 2.1a, 2.1b, 2.2a, 2.4a, 2.5c, 2.6a)

3rd Grade – Continuing to learn about Melodic Contour and do-re-mi with the Japanese song "Kuma San" – and continuing our new fishing boat song from Nigeria! We'll get to use LOTS of instruments!!! (TEKS: 3.1a, 3.1b, 3.2a, 3.2b, 3.3a, 3.5a, 3.5b)

4th Grade – We continue working on our PTA Program together in the Gym and on the stage!!! It will be Thursday, September 29th!

5th Grade – We begin working on our PTA Program! It will be Thursday, October 27th! We'll start learning songs for it this week, including a "Thrilling" recorder song!

6th Grade Choir - Continuing working on our first several songs, including songs for our Holiday Concert and Tour! (TEKS: 6.1a, 6.1b, 6.1c, 6.2a, 6.3a, 6.3c, 6.6a)
