

# This Week In Music...

Here, you'll find a brief Lesson Plan describing what we are learning and working on in Music Class this week, complete with the particular Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) taught or reinforced.

Here's what we're doing the week of September 5th in Music (no school on Monday for Labor Day – those classes will be made up on Friday):

Kindergarten - Starting the "Windy Day" book/song/game (TEKS: K.1a, K.1b, K.2a, K.3b, K.4a, K.4b)

1st Grade - Discovering loud/soft with the "Grizzly Bear" song/game (TEKS: 1.1a, 1.1b, 1.1c, 1.2a, 1.4a, 1.5a, 1.6a)

2nd Grade - Starting the "Millions of Cats" book/song/game (TEKS: 2.1a, 2.1b, 2.2a, 2.4a, 2.5c, 2.6a)

3rd Grade – Learning about Melodic Contour and do-re-mi with the Japanese song "Kuma San" – using a variety of pitched instruments! (TEKS: 3.1a, 3.1b, 3.2a, 3.2b, 3.3a, 3.5a, 3.5b)

4th Grade – We begin working on our PTA Program!!! It will be Thursday, September 29<sup>th</sup>! We already know one song for it – Oboa Asi Me Nsa!

5th Grade – Reviewing Music Form (A-B-A-C-A, etc.) and composing / playing our own eight-beat rhythm patterns (5.1b, 5.3a, 5.4b, 5.6a)

6th Grade Choir - Continuing working on our first several songs. (TEKS: 6.1a, 6.1b, 6.1c, 6.2a, 6.3a, 6.3c, 6.6a)
